Rules

1. Open to the world's gals and guys.
2. Must be 13 years of age to participate. Waiver must be signed to participate. If under 18 years of age - parent's signature required on waiver. Proof of age may be required.
3. Custom made 3 lb, 11 oz steel skillet provided by South Shuswap Canada Day
4. Best of 2 throws per contestant.
5. No practice throws permitted on site.
6. *For the Gals* – throw is straight out the course **for distance** at the final resting spot. *For the Guys* – throw is straight out the course **for accuracy** towards a bull's eye. Closest to centre of bull's eye wins. Accuracy will be marked at skillet's final resting spot.
7. Underhand only using the handle of the skillet.
8. Can take 3 steps to foul line "or" stand and fling underhand at the foul line. Winding up like "windmill pitching" okay as long as underhand.
9. Crossing foul line will disqualify the throw but will still count as one throw.
10. **The decision of the judges will be final.**

READ – Important

Put your name on the signup board after you have registered and filled in your waiver. This is the order that you will toss in.

In order to toss - you must hand your waiver to the "start line volunteer". **No waiver means no toss.**

You will need 2 nails with ribbons on them. Mark your name with the black marker on each ribbon. Give both of them to the "start line volunteer".

Arrive a bit early for your category. Line up according to where your name is on the sign up board.
